### Homework:

Our expectation at Broadford is that every child should do the following every night:

- 15 minutes reading to themselves or an adult and note in the reading record
- 15 minutes practicing spellings
- 15 minutes rehearsing times tables facts (including multiplication and division)
- If children would like to attempt an additional challenge, we have our weekly math challenge which can be found in the Year 1/2 blog page.

## Spellings:

The children will receive spellings each Monday in a red exercise book. These words will usually be either 'red words' (words that cannot be sounded out) or 'high frequency words' (words that they will use in the writing frequently). Please practise these spellings with your child each night.

Please ensure that your child brings their red spelling book to school every <u>Friday</u>. They will complete their test in the book as this allows you to see their results. We will then send new spellings home in the book each Monday.
